Numerically, the modern day Romanians are the third largest ethnic group in Romania after the Hungarians (37 percent of the population) and the Roma (14 percent). In the present, 8.7 million Romanian citizens live abroad, mainly in Europe, North America, Australia and New Zealand. Romanian communities existed in Western Ukraine (Chernigov Governorate), along the Danube, in Transylvania, northern Bessarabia and Northern Bukovina. However, these were later assimilated into the Romanian ethnic group. The present-day Romanian population in the world includes about 20 million people. The Danubian Principalities, predecessor states of present-day Romania, lost their independence in 1859. A quarter of the population of Romania was Romanian speaking Orthodox Christians, who could not find refuge in Bessarabia and the Budjak. The majority of Romanians who emigrated settled in Eastern Europe. The Romanian colonies were formed on the territory of former Danubian Principalities.
